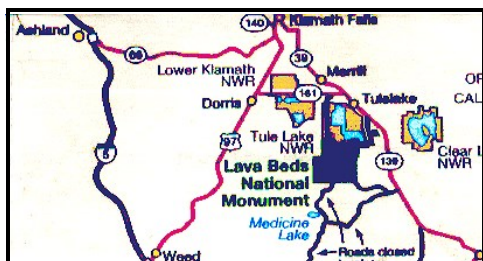

It is extremely important that students are dressed appropriately for this trip. The caves are 32 degrees and require a heavy sweatshirt. The ground is rough and uneven. Students must wear good fitting sneakers that do not slip on and off. Long pants are also a requirement, as the caves are cold and have many rough surfaces. Students also need to have a helmet or hard hat to wear in the caves. Bicycles helmets work well. A rain slicker or poncho is also recommended. NO UMBRELLAS ALLOWED.
